## ***Additional Fees and Charges***

- ❖ **Application Fee:** A \$250 *non-refundable* application fee is required for all new K-12<sup>th</sup> grade applicants. No application fee is required for Preschool Academy children.
- ❖ **Enrollment Fee:** The enrollment fee is paid at time of enrollment. Enrollment fees are non-refundable.
- ❖ **Returned Check Charge:** If a check is returned due to nonsufficient funds (NSF), your school account will be charged the NSF fee incurred by the school.
